APOLLO HITS HEIGHTS WITH STRONG QUARTERLY PERFORMANCE

Apollo Lifts, one of the UK's leading independent lift contractors, has announced one of its best trading quarters to date.

The strong performance has been fuelled by significant wins in key business areas, installations and service. Chief amongst these have been the £1million installation contract at St James's Hospital, Leeds, Europe's largest teaching hospital; a nationwide contract with Homebase for the maintenance of all platform lifts, further consolidating the company's retail credentials; a break into a completely new area, power stations, with a maintenance deal for several sites in the East Midlands; and a further 5% uplift in the number of NHS Trusts signing to Apollo under PASA.
